Large Area Maintenance Shelter (LAMS) are semi-mobile shelter platform systems that can deploy worldwide on a 72-hour notice. They are designed to support Force Projection and Staging Base operations for maintenance of aviation and ground combat vehicles. Each end of the shelter has a full width, full height clamshell type door. Each shelter is supplied with equipment for lighting, ventilation, and electrical door opening.
